

The 2022 Awards are:

Berniece E. Morris Scholarship

Award: The Berniece E. Morris Scholarship is an annual \$300 Memorial Academic Scholarship for Registered Nurses that are continuing their education in a formal academic program (RN to BSN, MSN, EdD, DNP, PhD, etc.).

Emerging Nurse Leader Award:

The Emerging Nurse Leader Award recognizes a nurse who provides inspiration and demonstrate commitment to those they serve.

Excellence in Nursing Leadership

Award: The Excellence in Nursing Leadership Award recognizes a nurse leader for their achievements in the profession and at their organization who demonstrates exemplary leadership in their healthcare specialty.

Outstanding Nursing Student Award:

The Outstanding Nursing Student Award recognizes an individual nursing student who is enrolled in a nursing program currently and demonstrates a commitment to the advancement of their education in a nursing program. The Leadership Succession Committee wishes to extend a call for chapter officer nominations for the office/committee positions listed below. Please feel free to nominate a potential candidate or self-nominate to serve your chapter — we need you!!

Positions for the 2022-24 Ballot include:

Note: the terms start July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2024

President-Elect:

The primary function of the President-Elect (two-year term) is to shadow the current president and observe Society operations until the end of the term, at which time the President-Elect succeeds into the role as president (two-year term). (four-year commitment)

Faculty Counselor:

The counselor is responsible for selecting candidates based on membership eligibility criteria determined by the Society bylaws and the exception guidelines chosen by the Governance Committee. The counselor is also responsible for sending membership invitations and managing the induction process. The counselor serves as Chair of the Governance Committee.

Secretary:

The Society secretary is responsible for recording and distributing meetings minutes, along with preparing and distributing Society correspondence. Secretaries can chair and/or serve on committees as needed.

Program Chair:

Leads the development of the Annual Conference, and two educational webinars each year. Serves as the Director of the Annual Research/Practice Conference.


